

## 12th Grade College Admissions Timeline

### Fall

- Complete College Visits
- Complete Common Application
- SAT/ACT/ASVAB/Accuplacer tests
- Create calendar with college app/financial app/scholarship app deadlines
- Finalize list of 10 colleges to submit applications to(3 safety/4 match/3 reach schools)
- Maintain high school academics
- Complete FAFSA/CSS Profile(2015 Tax Return)- **OCTOBER 1**
- Meet with Guidance Counselor
- Request letters of recommendations from guidance counselor and 2 Junior/Senior teachers
- Search/apply for scholarships
- Stay on track with grades and extra-curricular activities.

### Winter

- Act on results of early decision applications
- Complete 2016 Tax Return
- Follow up on submitted applications/submit additional necessary documents.
- Maintain high school academics
- Request First Semester Grades to all colleges that were applied to
- Search/apply for scholarships
- Stay on track with grades and extra-curricular activities.

### Spring

- Check out options if you're put on waitlist
- Watch mail/email for decision notification from colleges.
- Compare financial aid awards
- Complete enrollment paperwork for the college you will attend
- Complete institutional financial aid applications
- Create calendar with enrollment deadlines
- Final visit to chosen college
- Follow up on submitted financial aid documents/submit additional requested documents
- Inform all colleges of your decision
- Maintain high school academics
- Make final college decision(Usually May 1)
- Request final transcript to be sent to the college you will attend in the fall.
- Search/apply for scholarships
- Send deposit to your chosen college
- Stay on track with grades and extra-curricular activities.
- Watch mail/email for deadlines from chosen college.
