**CALAIS HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR RELEASE**  
**(LATE ARRIVAL/EARLY RELEASE)**

We will continue the practice of senior release at Calais High School for the 2017– 2018 school year. Any senior student who begins the school day or ends the school day with a study hall, maintains a record of good academic standing, and demonstrates a pattern of following school guidelines is eligible for early release privilege. With parental permission and approval of the school administrator, early release allows the qualifying senior to arrive at school following a first block study hall, or leave school following the student’s last class of the day provided the 4th block class is a study hall. Students must maintain a 77 (C-) average or above, in all classes, to maintain senior privileges. Grades will be checked approximately every 4 weeks at each academic checkpoint. Students who have accumulated 3 or more unexcused tardies per academic check point time period will lose senior privileges for the remainder of that academic period in addition to the following academic checkpoint period. Students who have multiple discipline infractions including (but not limited to): detention, Friday school, or suspension may also lose privileges at Administrative Discretion.

Any student who has been approved for “late arrival” must arrive at school and sign in at the office at 9:05AM and consistently get to Block 2 class on time. Any senior who has been approved for “early release” must leave the school building and grounds at the appointed early release time. The student must also sign out in the office. The “early release” student may return to school after dismissal to report to a teacher for extra help or for a school related activity. Students are also responsible for attending all advisory sessions and it is their responsibility to follow that schedule. “I forgot” is not an excuse. Skipping an advisory period is the same as skipping a regular class.

**Any Senior who is starting the year with at least 16 credits is automatically eligible for the first academic checkpoint period.**

**Any student granted Senior Privilege status may lose that privilege if the stated conditions of Senior Privilege are not maintained.**
