

Seniors: College Admissions Timeline

Fall

- Complete College Visits/ meet with representatives that come to the school
- Complete Common Application
- SAT/ ACT tests – If you want to retake exam, you must register yourself on Collegeboard.org
- Finalize list of colleges to submit applications to (Safety, match, reach schools)
- Maintain High School Academics
- Complete FAFSA – OCTOBER 1
- Meet with Guidance Counselor
- Request letters of recommendations from guidance counselor and 2 junior/senior teachers
- Search/Apply for scholarships
- Stay on track with grades and extra-curricular activities

Winter

- Act on results of early decision applications (If applicable)
- Follow up on submitted applications/submit additional necessary documents
- Complete Tax return
- Search and apply for scholarships
- Complete scholarship packet that is given out at school (February)
- Stay on track with grades and extra-curricular activities

Spring

- Check out other options if put on wait list
- Watch mail/ email for decision notification from colleges
- Compare financial aid awards
- Complete enrollment paperwork for the college you will attend
- Complete financial aid applications
- Visit chosen college
- Inform all colleges of your decision
- Make final college decision –by May 1st
- Search apply for scholarships
- Send Deposit to your chosen college
- Stay on track with grades and extra-curricular activities
- Watch mail/ email for deadlines from chosen college
